Decorating Tips

- Secure ornaments to trees using zip ties, pipe cleaner, string, wire or other ties. Ornament hooks will fall off.
- Do not use water-soluble glue on ornaments
- Spray any fabrics with Scotch Guard to prevent mildew.

Supplies to Use

- LED lights ONLY.
- Durable decorations that are able to children potentially touching and grabbing.
- Zip-ties, pipe cleaners, string or other ties to secure your decorations.
- Plastic drop cloth or other covering for the ground if you plan to spray paint your tree.

Who organizes this event?

Winter Wonderland is a collaborative effort from several local organizations. These include: Breaking Bred, Invigorating Touch, Kellogg Arena, Penetrator Events, Small Business Development Office through the City of Battle Creek, and Sprout Co-Op.

Is there a cost to view?

This event is free and open to the public.

Where is this located?

The Holiday Tree Forest will be located inside Kellogg Arena (1 McCamly Sq) for the duration of Winter Wonderland (December 1-2).

Who decorates the trees?

Each tree is adopted by a local business/organization. Trees can have themes that match the organization's mission or they can be entirely unique. Each tree will have a sign with the names of the sponsor and decorations.

I am participating, when do I need to decorate my tree?

Trees will be available to decorate on Thursday, November 30 at Kellogg Arena. All trees will need to be fully decorated by 3pm Thursday to set them up for the following day's festivities.
